NABI of DFW is an amateur, handicap bowling tournament club that is open to any bowler that has an average of 215 or below. There is an initial membership fee of \$25.00 and an annual renewal fee of \$15.00

We work closely with center managers to insure that our tournaments are bowled on sport type patterns and NOT on the house pattern.

Our handicap is 90% of 205.

Your highest book average from the last 3 years will be the basis for your entering average. If you have no book average, your highest current league average of at least 21 games will be the basis average. **Your actual entering average will be the basis average converted to a sport average using the USBC conversion chart.** The entering average will be used until you establish a NABI average which is your average when you have cashed for \$300.00 or you have bowled 60 games. Once established, the NABI average is based on your last 60 games including qualifying, semifinals and finals but not optionals. Members who have not bowled a tournament in the last 6 months will re-establish averages as a new member. New members can expect their scores and NABI average to be lower than what they are used to bowling due to the more difficult conditions.

Most NABI tournaments are singles events with other formats such as doubles and trio team events held on a few weekends. Entry fees are between \$50 and \$80, depending on the format and the advertised payout. The higher entry fees are for holiday tournaments and major club events. The prize fund will ALWAYS pay back at least 60% of the entry fees. For the \$50.00 entry fee, \$30.00 goes to the prize fund, \$10 is for lineage, \$2.00 goes to the year-end tournament, \$1.50 is a franchise fee to NABI National and \$6.50 covers expenses such as added monies to the prize fund, credit card fees, website fees, employees and other operational expenses.

For singles tournaments held over 2 or more days, there are qualifying squads followed by semifinals and then finals. One day singles tournaments usually have qualifying followed by finals. Men and women qualify separately. Women always qualify 1 in 4 and men qualify 1 in 5 on Saturdays and 1 in 6 on Sunday unless it is otherwise noted. For most tournaments, **the first squad of every day is a "seeded" squad where the high handicap man and woman are automatically placed in the semifinals.** All semifinalists are guaranteed to cash. Tournaments have several qualifying squads and re-entries are accepted. Qualifying consists of 3 games across 6 lanes. Please see page 4 for semis and finals information.

Brackets and side-pots are available in every tournament. "Optionals" are also offered. Optionals are for bowlers who have qualified for the semis or who are above the "cut line". They may pay \$10.00 for lineage and bowl for brackets and other available side action, such as cross-over doubles and Hi/Lo singles but not for any of the ICC payouts. Optionals do not **count towards a member's average.**

On average, non-holiday singles tournament champions receive \$1,049.00 with progressive. All advertised projected first place payouts include progressive unless otherwise stated. See page 3 for more information on progressives.

USBC Sport Bowling Average Adjustment Scale:

Please see below the USBC conversion chart.

This tells you the average difference between a "league" condition verses a "sport" lane condition.

We will use this chart for new members. The entering average will be used until you establish a NABI average, which is your average when you have cashed for \$300 or you have bowled 60 games.

New members can expect their scores and NABI average to be lower than what they are used to bowling due to the difficult conditions.

NABI DRESS CODE:

Members are required to wear a collared shirt with their first and last name on the back of the shirt and the letters NABI or a NABI patch on the sleeve or chest area. Please let us know if you need a patch. In the event you forget your NABI shirt, we do have "loaner" shirts available for \$20. The \$20 can be waived if you purchase a shirt.

New members have 60 days from the time they join to get a NABI shirt. You can obtain the shirt on your own or they may be purchased through NABI of DFW.

Jeans, slacks, skirts or shorts** may be worn. Athletic/gym/jogging type shorts and pants are not allowed.

HEADWEAR IS NOT ALLOWED.

PRE PAYMENT:

Members can pre-pay the entry fee for their first squad of a tournament and receive a \$5.00 discount on the entry fee. Pre-payment must be made at least 24 hours prior to the start of a tournament. Members can put \$50.00 in an escrow account and be pre-paid all the time. Being pre-paid will save you \$5.00 every tournament you bowl.

PROGRESSIVE POT:

Progressive Pot is an UPGRADE in the prize monies for first through fourth place. The cost is \$10.00 for your first squad and \$5.00 for each re-entry. 75% of the money collected for a tournament will go to first through fourth place and 25% will be carried over to the next tournament. If any one of the four places is not in the progressive pot, that person's share will be carried over to the next tournament in addition to the 25%.

New NABI members will not be allowed to participate in the progressive pot until their fourth NABI tournament. Then the first, second and third time they participate in the progressive pot, they will only be eligible for a partial progressive payout which will pay: 1st - \$200.00, 2nd - \$100.00, third - \$40.00 and 4th - \$40.00. The remainder of the progressive pot is carried over. After the third time, they are eligible for full progressive.

All members must participate in the progressive pot at least once every 45 days to stay on the eligible list. After 45 days, they will have to re-qualify for the progressive pot as a new member.

Semifinals: Qualified bowlers will bowl 3 games across 6 lanes.

Top 8 Finals: The top 8 handicap scores from the semifinals will advance to the Top 8 Finals. The format is bracket style, one game, match play. Finalists are seeded by score with 1 vs 8, 2 vs 7, 3 vs 6, etc.

Top 16 Finals: The top 16 handicap scores from the semifinals will advance to the Top 16 Finals. The format is bracket style, one game, match play. Finalists are seeded by score with 1 vs 16, 2 vs 15, 3 vs 14, etc.

Top 5 Finals: The Top 5 is a stepladder finals. The top 5 handicap scores from the semifinals will advance to the Top 5 Finals and will be seeded by score. The 5th seed will bowl the 4th seed. Then the winner of that match will bowl the 3rd seed and so on.

Shoot-out Finals: There are no semifinals. After the qualifying rounds are over, those making the cut will bowl one game. The top half will again bowl one game followed by a cut to the top half. This is repeated until 4 bowlers are left. Those 4 will bowl one game for positions 1 through 4.

Annual Events:

Doubles Tournament: Two members bowl 2 games across 4 lanes. Their scores are combined and posted. This tournament is score only and does not have semifinals or finals. There are several squads and members can re-enter using the same or different partners.

Team Tournament: This tournament is for teams consisting of 3 members or two members and one guest. The team will bowl 3 games across 6 lanes. This event is score only and does not have semifinals or finals. There are several squads and members can re-enter using the same or different team members.

Side Events:

Cross Over Doubles: Pair up with a partner(s) bowling on your squad. Combine your scores from the squad and that's your score. Cash ratio is 1-8. This event is run in conjunction with another event.

High-Low Pot: During a qualifying squad, you combine your high and low handicap games for your score. Cash ratio is 1-8. This event is run in conjunction with another event.

INNER CIRCLE CLUB (ICC):

ICC is a "sidepot" that costs \$10.00 per squad. Participation is optional. ICC includes the following:

Insurance: If you bowl at least 7 pins over your average each game and do not make the cut to the semis, you will receive a free entry to the next NABI tournament. \$50 Value

Mystery Score: A score will be drawn each squad. If you bowled that score during the first game, you will be awarded \$75.00

70/85 Pins Over Average: Ladies that shoot 70 pins over their average and men who shoot 85 pins over their average will be awarded \$75.00.

9 Pin No Tap: Highest ICC entered qualifier on each squad will bowl 9 pin no tap across 12 lanes. At least 9 pins must be knocked down to advance to the next lane. \$3.00 will be awarded for each 9 count and \$5.00 for each strike. 9 or better across 12 lanes wins \$500.00 (\$300 for new members).

NABI CHAMPIONS

All NABI of DFW Champions will receive a "Champ Package". The Champ package consists of 2 NABI Champion shirts or one NABI Champion shirt and a Champion jacket. It also includes a free entry into the Tournament of Champions in the National Tournament and into the NABI of DFW Open.

Lucy Doctor Bowler of the Year Award

The Lucy Doctor Bowler of the Year Award is given on a point system. Members earn points by bowling tournaments, cashing, recruiting new members and bowling over your average. The bowler with the most points at the end of the year will be declared "Bowler of the Year". The winner receives one free entry into EVERY local tournament the upcoming year.

NABI of DFW Open

This tournament is the biggest local prize fund event of the year. In 2010, first place won \$6,000.00. Members must qualify for this tournament by bowling 8 tournaments and 30 games from January, 2011 through the tournament before the Open. Please see the flyer for more information.

FREE ENTRY

For every new bowler that you recruit to bowl NABI, you will receive a free entry. The bowler MUST have NEVER bowled a NABI event. \$50.00 Value

YEAR END TOURNAMENT

Starting in January of every year, we take \$2.00 from every entry and put it into a year-end fund. At the end of the year, we have a tournament and add all the money that has been accrued to the prize fund. In order to qualify for this tournament, you must have bowled 8 tournaments and 30 games from January, 2011 through December, 2011. Typically, there is approximately \$7,000 to \$8,000 in added monies.

YEAR END BANQUET

In January of every year, we have a sit down dinner at a local hotel. Awards are presented and we talk about the upcoming events. We have an A+ dinner, dancing and most all we have a GREAT time!! Usually this event is the 2nd weekend in January.
